

Make a Safety Poster

Materials

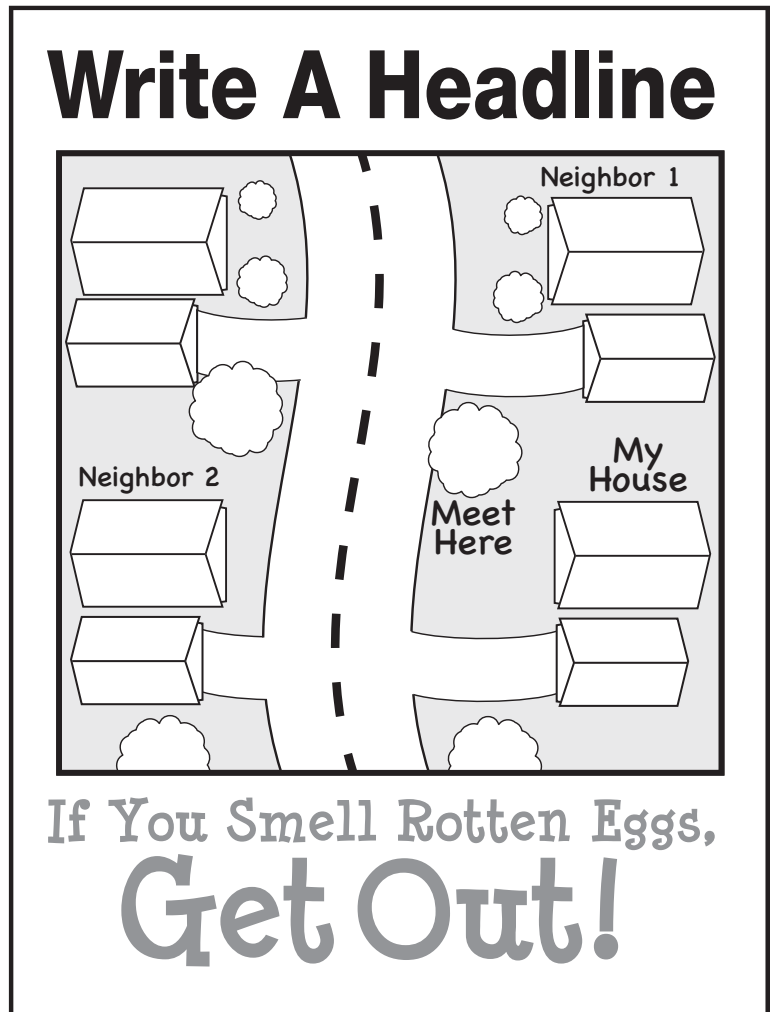
- Posterboard
- Markers

Objective

Students will brainstorm, plan, organize and create a safety poster illustrating ways to be safe at home around natural gas.

Procedure

- Review with your students how to be safe around natural gas. Remind them if they smell rotten eggs to get out of the house quickly and tell an adult. Ask them what other ways they can be safe at home.
- Have the students draw their neighborhood and mark where their home is. Have them designate a meeting point outside of their home in case of a natural gas leak.
- Next, have students mark which neighbors would be good resources to go to if their parents or guardians are not available.
- Instruct the students to add a headline to their poster and to write, "If You Smell Rotten Eggs, Get Out!"
- Have each student share their poster with the class. Instruct the students to take the posters home and share with their families.



Discussion Questions

1. Why is important to have a safety plan?

- *To make sure that you and your family know what to do before an emergency occurs.*

2. What other things might you need a safety plan for?

- *In case of a fire, electrical outage, earthquake or tornado.*
