



WHAT DO YOU KNOW ABOUT NATURAL GAS?

A long, long time ago, dead fish, plants and animals were covered over with layers of dirt and rock. When the chemicals from the dead plants and animals mixed with heat and large amounts of pressure under the land, natural gas was created! Natural gas is safe to use, but sometimes it can leak.

And that is dangerous because it can cause a fire.

Natural gas has no smell when it comes out of the ground, so scientists add chemicals to make it smell like rotten eggs. That way you know if there's danger.
